

4-H Horse Program Project Animal Policies

- 1. All equines must have been officially designed as the member's project animal by June 1 of the 4-H year. A copy of the completed horse or Donkey/Mule Certificate along with rabies and Coggins certificates will be kept on file with 4-H office.
- 2. Members may designate all personally or family owned horses as project animals. Family will be defined as the legal guardian, as well as husband, wife, parent, step-parents, step child, brother, sister, half brother and sister, grandmother and grandfather and in-laws of the same relation.
- 3. Members not owning or not using a family owned equine may designate <u>one</u> non-owned horse as their project animal. (designate non-owned on the project animal certificate).
- 4. A 4-H member who owns or leases a horse or pony may also own or lease a miniature equine and/or a donkey or mule or driving horse that is only used for driving.
